

## MGC LEAGUES CAPTIAN'S MEETING AGENDA

## 03/23/2022

- 6:00PM call the meeting to order.
- TEAM FEES:
  - Team fees will be \$100.00 for each team up to 10 members.
  - \$10.00 will be added for each additional member up to a maximum of 15 members per team.
  - Team fees must be paid prior to close of business during the first week of league shooting.
  - Individual Leagues will be a \$10.00 per person at sign up. Individual leagues will consist of Dbls Skeet, Dbls Trap, Handicap Trap.
- League Procedures:
  - Teams will be comprised of at least 5 shooters.
  - League rosters need to be finalized by the end of week 1. No exceptions!
  - The league season will be 21 weeks long. The first full week of April will be practice or "fun week". Scoring will begin the following week of April. The last week of leagues is in Sept 22 weeks from the first week.
  - Each shooter will attempt 50 targets per week for score.
  - Each squad will be limited to 5 for trap and sporting clays and 6 for skeet.
  - Each squad will hold a field for a maximum of 2 rounds. If others are waiting to use the field.
  - No field reservations. Check in at the front counter when your squad is ready to go out. Ie ... Don't have one person get here 1 hr

early and try to reserve a field and then it sits empty waiting for everyone else to show.

- Leagues will have priority for fields. This includes high school leagues. This is relative to your teams League night. I.E. If your team shoots on Tuesday and you come out to shoot on Thursday you may have to yield to the Thursday teams and rotate in with any open shooters who come to shoot that night.
- All teams will be competing in a running average league.
- Sporting Clay League scores will be posted every three weeks after all teams have completed the rotation of targets.
- Round scoring:
  - You will declare in advance that the rounds are for league and they must be scored on the team's league sheet. Shooters are responsible for getting the team league sheets to the scorers and returning them to the club. Practice rounds must be declared in advance and scored on daily practice sheets. If you as a team, squad or individual decide to shoot a league round and not have it scored on a league sheet and the score gets lost it is lost, it is your responsibility. Also if you decide to split your team to two fields (not recommended) if scores are not transferred and lost shoot them over.
  - If a team takes the score sheet home. It will be your responsibility to get it and get the proper scores on it in a timely manner.
  - Shoot Backs and Shoot aheads.
    - Until the 4<sup>th</sup> of July weekend shoot backs will be open for all teams this is to help out those who want to make up scores do to being out of state, college, or simply being too crowded during the high school season.
    - After the 4th<sup>t</sup> of July weekend Shooters can shoot back 1 week through week 18. (19, 20 & 21 being the final tourney)

- If a shooter is shooting back or forward they are responsible to know what week they are shooting and get the appropriate score sheet for that week.
- If two scores for one shooter appear on one weeks sheet the second will be disregarded and not applied to the following week.
- Shoot ahead scores can be shot ahead through the final week for Trap and Skeet. Sporting Clay leagues must complete their rounds within the three week target set. Shooting ahead only if the targets have been reset for that week in the finals.
- Handicaps will be established after the first 50 targets calculated by subtracting a shooters raw average from 48 and multiplying the difference by 70%. Handicaps will be adjusted after every week a shooter has a league score. No raw score plus handicap can exceed 48 unless
  - A shooter shoots one score of 25 and the second score with handicap is 24 totaling 49.
  - A shooter shoots 2 rounds of 25 totaling 50.
- The top five scores per team each week will count for competition.
- If fewer than five members shoot, a blind score of 15 will be inserted as necessary.
- Handicap and doubles Leagues will be 300 bird Leagues shot anytime during League season. When fields are available. Friday will have one field dedicated to Handicap and one for doubles if possible.
- Handicap yardage will start at your ATA yardage or the 20 yard line if there is no ATA yardage established. Scores of 24 or higher will gain you an additional ½ yard back to a max of the 27 yard line.
- Individual league champions are based on High Gun Average in that league.
- Final tournament weeks will be weeks 19, 20 and 21 for all disciplines. Number of classes determined by number of teams

shooting each discipline. Loading an 8 team bracket as balanced as possible. In the event of a bye, the team is not required to shoot unless the individual shooter is competing for High Gun. There will not be any shoot backs during the tournament weeks. However, shoot ahead will be allowed for trap and skeet or Sporties if the targets have been set. Bracket placement is done by team rankings as of Sunday end of week 18. Seeding as follows. Top bracket 1 vs 8, 4 vs 5, bottom bracket 2 vs 7, 3 vs 6

- Any Shooter, shooting in the final tournament must have been on the roster for the season and have shot at least 10 weeks of regular league.
- Scores for the league will be posted each Monday following that week of shooting.
- During the final tournament weeks if there is a tie, there will be a shoot off between the two teams. In the event both teams tie in the shoot off, the raw score shot in the shoot off will determine the winning team.
- If you are competing for High Gun in Trap, Skeet or Sporties, you must shoot all 21 weeks.
- League half way and end parties:
  - The league half way party will be the week of June 14<sup>th</sup>- 16<sup>th</sup>, week
    10 of league.
  - $\circ$  The end of league party will be the 21<sup>st</sup> week of League in Sept.
  - During both parties Food will be served between 4 PM and 8 PM. Please plan accordingly.
- Trophies/hats:
  - Presentation of the summer and Fall League Champions will be at the following Captains meeting.
- Registered events:
  - Once again we have provided a copy of the MGC Calendar of events.
  - Additional dates to keep in mind:

- We will be closed Sunday April 17th , Easter Sunday.
- April 3<sup>rd</sup> final Jackpot Sporties
- April 3rd and May 1<sup>st</sup>, High School SCTP trap and Skeet tourney
- Saturday May 21<sup>st</sup> ATA spring fling trap shoot.
- Jun 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup>, High School Pre State Warm Up -Trap/skeet
- Jun 20 through the 25<sup>th</sup> MSHSL Trap & Skeet Tourneys (Saturday is the rain date) no leagues this week
- Fun Shoots:
  - Annie Oakley's, Scrap for Fun etc. can be shot after leagues and if there isn't people backed up waiting for fields.
- Safety Regulations:
  - All MGC Safety protocols must be maintained. This includes no drinking of alcoholic beverages during or prior to shooting.
  - With fifteen High Schools practicing and competing here we must provide them an alcohol free atmosphere. For this reason they will be limited to Traps 7, 8, 9, and 10 and 3 for skeet. Any drinking and after shoot actives will be kept to the two western most pavilions.

## Card system:

We will be using the target management system. Members may use member pricing for themselves only. Non members must purchase non member rounds and use there own card. Any misuse of this system will result in the member loosing their membership status and forfeiting any and all rounds outstanding.
